2017 Chrysler Pacifica Sub-Model Identification for 118712 and 118723

The 2017 Chrysler Pacifica is available in 5 different sub-models, LX, Limited, Touring, Touring-L and Touring-L Plus. Pacifica sub-models can be difficult to identify due to vague or lack of badging. An example is we have seen some models with no badging as well as Touring-L Plus and Touring-L models that simply have a Touring badge, this can be misleading. You can correctly identify these vehicles either by the original window sticker, by the 7th digit in the VIN (Vehicle Identification Number) or identifying the color of the tail light assemblies' connector using the methods below. You may also be able decode the VIN on various internet sites. This will ensure you purchase to correct T-One Connector.

VIN Codes

LX = C Touring = D Limited = G Touring-L = B Touring-L Plus = E

Identify Connector Color

The most accurate way to determine the correct T-One Connector is to remove the tail light assembly and identify the color of the connector attached to the tail light (tail light does not need to be unplugged) To remove tail light, open the rear tailgate to access the bolts that hold the taillights in place. Using a Torx T27 Socket & Ratchet or Torx T27 Wrench, remove the taillight on either the driver and passenger side of the vehicle. After removing the screws, carefully pull the taillights away from the vehicle being careful not to damage the alignment pins. Note Connector color and reinstall tail light assembly. Use photos to the left to determine correct T-One Connector.
