2. Bolts will need to be pulled through access holes in frame with supplied pull wire (see below).










NISSAN TITAN CREW CAB & KING CAB DETERMINE CLEARANCE NEEDED BETWEEN RV AND TRUCK CAB FOR A 90 DEGREE TURN

- 1. The instructions assume that the RV has a Reese® SidewinderTM with 22" from pivot to kingpin installed on the RV.
- 2. Find the corner of the RV and tape on a string about 6 feet above the ground. Be sure that the string is hanging straight down. Add a small weight if needed.
- 3. Establish a line across the front of the pin box wings. Extend this "straight" line out to the edge of the RV. See figure 1 below.
- 4. Measure from this line to the string on the corner. This dimension will be called "X".
- 5. Looking at the chart below, find your bed length and RV width. The table displays the **maximum** "X" dimension you can have without hitting your truck cab.
