- 2. Many Blue Ox® Baseplates are designed to use existing holes and hardware to mount the baseplate to the towed vehicle. Even though bolts are there, do not assume they are adequate for baseplate mounting. Always use hardware supplied in the hardware kit and existing hardware specified in the Baseplate Installation Instructions.



Important:

Use only genuine factory replacement parts on your baseplate. Do NOT substitute homemade or non-typical parts. If a bolt is lost or in need of replacement, for your safety and the preservation of your baseplate, be sure to use a replacement bolt of the same grade (In most cases it will be Grade 5, please reference the parts list above). Replacement parts may be ordered through your nearest Blue Ox® Dealer or Distributor, or call our Customer Care Team at (402)385-3051. Failing to follow and/or altering these installation instructions in either installation or required equipment will void the manufacturer's warranty.

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Attachment Tabs: Motorhome mount tow bars are recommended for use with this baseplate. Due to the design of the removable tabs, the RangeFinderII and Ambassador tow bars can not be used. Adapters, except the BX8833 and BX88151, can not be used with this baseplate.

Instruction Notes: The front fascia and air baffle are removed for the baseplate installation. Drilling is required. Trimming of the air dam and the fascia is required.


The dimensional variations between otherwise identical vehicles can be considerable. While the baseplate was designed for easy installation, it may be necessary to tailor the baseplate slightly to compensate for auto manufacturer's tolerances. These minor adjustments may include filing a hole slightly, bending electrical rods or bending end plates.

The BX8848 Four Diode Wiring Kit is recommended for this vehicle.



Just forward of the front tire, on the edge of the wheel well cover, remove four pushpins. Do this to both sides of the vehicle. Set pushpins aside to reinstall later.

Installation Instructions



 Using the 10MM socket, remove six bolts from the black plastic cover on the driver's top side of the fascia (white arrows). Using the Phillips screwdriver, remove the two Phillips pushpins (gray arrows). On the passenger side remove five bolts and two pushpins. Set bolts, pushpins and plastic cover aside to reinstall later.



 Also just forward of the front tire, on the edge of the wheel well cover, using the 10MM socket, remove the bolt. Do this to both sides of the vehicle. Set bolts aside to reinstall later.

Handling of some cosmetic parts when installing this product may require the use of protective covers, rags, specialty tools, etc. to prevent damage.

Do not use the towed vehicle for storing luggage, equipment, etc. This may cause you to exceed the towing capacity of the tow bar, baseplate, and its accessories.

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4. Using the 7MM socket, remove nine metric bolts from underneath corner of the front fascia, forward of the front tire, as indicated by the white arrow in the photo above. Remove two pushpins, as indicated by the grey arrow in the photo above. Do this around the vehicle. Remove fascia by pulling it out to the side and forward a little bit. Set fascia, bolts and pushpins aside carefully to reinstall later.



6. Using the 10MM socket, remove one metric bolt from the back side of the air baffle. Set air baffle and bolt aside to reinstall later.




5. Remove pushpin from the passenger's side air baffle. Set air baffle and pushpin aside to reinstall later.



7. Remove pushpin from the bottom of the bumper. Do this on both sides. Set pushpin aside to reinstall later.

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


8. Using the utility knife, trim the piece of plastic right next to the radiator flush with the bottom of the bumper. Discard the lower portion. Do this on both sides.



10. **2010-11 Models:** Mark the air dam straight across the top and straight down the side, as shown, and trim.






9. **2008-09 Models:** Mark the passenger's side of the air dam straight down 3 inches where the hole is and around the contour of the air dam mold.



11. Also on the driver's side, mark straight down from the air dam tab three inches and horizontally back to the air dam contour and trim this area with the utility knife.

12. Align the baseplate on the driver's side so the upper back hole aligns with the existing horn bracket hole and clamp in place with vise grips. Reinstall the horn bracket with the existing bolt. Using the baseplate as a template, drill the remaining three holes into the frame rail on the driver's side with the 13/32" drill bit.

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


13. Align the baseplate on the passenger's side so the upper back hole aligns with the existing air intake value hole into which a push pin will be inserted. Using the baseplate as a template, drill the three remaining holes into the frame rail on the passenger's side with the 13/32" drill bit.

BE SURE TO USE LOCTITE® RED ON ALL BOLTS
BEFORE TIGHTENING. TIGHTEN ALL BOLTS
ACCORDING TO THE TORQUE CHART ON THE FRONT
PAGE OF THESE INSTRUCTIONS OR ON PAGE 3 OF
THE BASEPLATE TOWING GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS.



15. Take the rubber out of the air baffle in order to get the plug back in it.




14. Insert two 3/8-16 x 1" hex bolts, 3/8-16 hex nuts and 3/8 lock washers into the bottom two holes. Use Loctite Red on all the bolts. Guide a 1" nut plate up through the opening in the bottom of the frame rail and align it with the upper front bolt hole. Install the 3/8-16 x 1 1/2" hex bolt and the 3/8" lock washer to the 1" nut plate, as indicated by the grey arrow in the photo above. Do the same on the passenger side.


When using power drills be aware of the dangers of torque and drill bit length.



16. Reinstall the horn on the driver's side.

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- 17. Hold fascia as close to the original location as possible and mark area to be removed. Trim 2 1/2" of the upper rib off to give room for baseplate. Do this on both sides of the vehicle. Some models may need more trimming (gray arrows) check the fascia fit.
- 18. Attach baseplate safety cables to the frame of the vehicle. The cables should be secure to a solid piece of the vehicle frame. Be sure the safety cables do not rub against any hoses.

Be sure that ALL electrical connections are plugged in properly and functioning BEFORE Installing the fascia.

19. Reinstall fascia inserting all bolts and pushpins. Installation of the baseplate is now complete.

Install the tow bar and safety cables according to the instructions when demonstrating this to the customer. Be sure to included all the contents and packages.

Do **NOT** substitute other devices of the tow bar pins and clips are misplaced.
