## **MARNING**

Failure to read and follow these instructions could result in separation of the towed vehicle from the tow bar, causing property damage, loss of towed vehicle, personal injury or death.

**Instruction Notes:** The fascia, bumper, frame extensions and windshield washer fluid reservoir are removed and reinstalled for the baseplate installation. Some drilling and trimming is required.

Place all components that are removed on a flat, sturdy surface. All items will be reinstalled unless otherwise noted after the baseplate is installed.

The dimensional variations between otherwise identical vehicles can be considerable. While the baseplate was designed for easy installation, it may be necessary to tailor the baseplate slightly to compensate for vehicle manufacturer's tolerances.

The BX8869 Tail Light Wiring Kit is recommended for this vehicle.




Drill a hole according to the tail light wiring kit instructions.

#### **NOTICE**

- Handling of some cosmetic parts when installing this product may require the use of protective covers, rags, specialty tools, etc. to prevent damage.
- When using power drills be aware of the dangers of torque and drill bit length.
- When using a reciprocating saw be aware of objects behind the cutting surface.
- Use a good quality paint to spray cut edges of frame to prevent rusting.
- Be sure that **ALL** electrical connections are plugged in and accessories are functioning properly before reinstalling the fascia.
- The baseplate is computer tested to your vehicle's GVWR, exceeding this weight will void the manufacturer's warranty.
- Be sure to use Loctite® Red on all bolts before tightening. Tighten all bolts according to the torque chart provided.
- Dealer or installer be certain the user receives these instruction sheets.
- If the baseplate is in an accident, it must be replaced. **DO NOT** use it again! An accident can cause unseen damage and using it again could result in more damage or serious injury. **DO NOT** use the baseplate if it is damaged or missing parts.



#### Important:

Use only genuine factory replacement parts on your baseplate. Do **NOT** substitute homemade or non-typical parts. If a bolt is lost or in need of replacement, for your safety and the preservation of your baseplate, be sure to use a replacement bolt of the same grade (In most cases it will be Grade 5, please reference the parts list above). Replacement parts may be ordered through your nearest Blue Ox® Dealer or Distributor. Failing to follow and/ or altering these installation instructions in either installation or required equipment will void the manufacturer's warranty. Towing behind a non-motorized vehicle will void the warranty.




1. Remove the two (2) push pins from the top edge of the fascia.



Using a flat screwdriver, release the clip towards the driver side.



3. Pull back on the top of the fascia and remove the two (2) push pins underneath.



4. Pull back the wheel well liner. Then using a 10MM socket, remove the screw from the fascia/fender joint.



 Using a 10MM socket, remove the two (2) screws from underside of the fascia (white). Then remove the outer push pin (gray). Do this on both sides of the vehicle.

Note: On some models there will be three (3) screws in lieu of two (2) screws and a push pin.



6. Remove the six (6) push pins from the underside of the fascia towards the center.



Using a 10MM socket, remove the two


 (2) screws from the washer reservoir.
 Disconnect/Plug all lines, separate the reservoir from the filler tube and set aside.




8. Trim the plastic shrouding just below the bumper back to the seam for baseplate clearance. Do this on both sides of the vehicle.




 On the driver side, using a 14MM socket, remove the four (4) bolts from the bumper reinforcement bracket. The bracket will not be reinstalled.




10. Remove the styrofoam filler from the bumper. Then using a 12MM socket, remove the six (6) screws from the bumper. There are two (2) on the passenger side and four (4) on the driver side. Set the bumper aside.



11. On the driver side, using a 14MM socket, remove the four (4) bolts from the frame extension and set aside. Repeat on the passenger side, removing the three (3) bolts from the frame extension.




12. On the passenger side, using a reciprocating saw, trim out the upper portion of the frame face and cut two (2) slits back to the frame side. Bend the face back around flush to the frame side.



13. Trim the driver side similar to the passenger side except the lower portion with the factory nut will need to be removed for baseplate clearance.




14. Temporarily reinstall the frame extensions and mark the backsides around the frame cuts. Remove the extensions and trim these areas with a reciprocating saw.




15. On the driver side, flatten the ridge flush with the frame side.



16. On the driver side, using a 10MM socket, remove the screw from the electrical bracket. Slide the bracket up the frame and reinstall in a higher position.



17. On the passenger side, remove the two (2) push pins from the shielding (white). Then squeeze the two (2) clips to release the shielding from the vehicle giving access for nut plate insertion into the frame.




18. Position the baseplate onto the vehicle, aligning the top front edge of the baseplate with the frame rail, while pulling the baseplate as forward as possible. Level and securely clamp the baseplate to the frame.

Using a 13/32" drill bit, drill the top front hole thru the frame. Install a 3/8"-16 x 1-1/4" bolt with lock washer and lock nut on the inside of the frame. Do this on both sides of the vehicle. Fully tighten all hardware.


19. Continue drilling the remaining baseplate holes thru the frame. Note: the bottom rear hole is used on the driver side and the bottom middle hole is used on the passenger side. Install a 3/8"-16 x 1-1/4" bolt with lock washer and lock nut plate on the inside of the frame in the top back hole (black).

Install a 3/8"-16 x 2" bolt with lock washer and lock nut plate on the inside of the frame in the bottom back hole (gray), using the provided spacer in between the frame and baseplate.



Install the appropriate 3/8" bolt with lock washer into the bottom front hole and use 3/8" nut plates on the inside of the frame. Note the driver side may require the use od washers in between the frame and baseplate.


Do this on both sides of the vehicle. Fully tighten all hardware.



20. Trim the off the attachment plate from the driver side of the bumper for baseplate clearance.



21. Reinstall the plastic shielding, frame extensions, bumper, styrofoam filler and washer reservoir.



22. Attach the permanent baseplate safety cables to the provided convenience link on the baseplate. The photo above shows the recommended installation of the cables to frame of vehicle. Additional options may interfere with suggested mounting; in this case, secure the cables to a solid piece of the frame as described in the instructions included with the permanent baseplate safety cables. Be sure the safety cables do not rub against any hoses or moving parts. Do this on **BOTH** sides of the vehicle.



23. **Optional Breakaway:** Fasten the bracket to the underside of the bumper with a #10 screw at the desired location. Install the breakaway to the bracket with the supplied 1/4" bolt and lock nut.



24. Reinstall the fascia.

- 2. It is the owner's responsibility to inspect all towing equipment for cracked welds, missing or worn parts and loose bolts before each towing trip. Be sure to use Loctite® Red on all bolts and tighten to the recommended specifications.
- 3. It is the owner's responsibility to hook up all towing equipment per manufacturer's instructions/recommendations.
- 4. Remove the attachment tabs when not in use (if applicable).

## **Notice To Baseplate Installer**

- 1. It is YOUR responsibility to watch for:
  - Oil cooler and air conditioner lines
  - Electrical wires and hoses
  - Missing parts or attaching points on the frame
  - \*\* If the baseplate is improperly installed and is against a wire or hose, it could cause fluid leaks or electrical shorts some time after the actual baseplate installation.

#### **Permanent Baseplate Safety Cable Installation**

Permanent baseplate safety cables are strongly recommended when towing a vehicle with a tow bar. The principle function of the permanent baseplate safety cables is to prevent the towed vehicle from breaking loose in the event the connection between the frame of the towed vehicle and the baseplate fails or becomes disconnected. The cables must be connected from the baseplate to the frame rail or cross member of the vehicle's frame. The illustrations below show the possible arrangements recommended by Blue Ox®. Each permanent baseplate safety cable must have an adequate weight rating for the towing system. The weight rating of the two (2) cables together will not qualify.

#### Do not mount the permanent baseplate safety cables against wires, hoses or brake lines.

These permanent baseplate safety cables should remain installed as long as the baseplate is installed on the vehicle. Permanent baseplate safety cables are to be used in conjunction with, and NOT a replacement for legally required safety cables attaching the towed vehicle to the towing vehicle.
